easy-going

The YBNCT meetings should gather students and young researchers in a friendly environment, where they share their work and participate actively.

inclusive

YBNCT meetings should be inclusive.

For that reason, they should be organized as low-cost meetings.

If possible, no fee or a symbolic fee should be charged for participating.

The ISNCT should support these meetings, by helping some researchers to attend through travel grants.

interactive

Some interactive sessions should be added (e.g., workshops, hands-on activities, ...).

Social activities should be included in the program. It would be very convenient if all the participants are accommodated in the same place during the meeting.

focused

The YBNCT meetings should be focused to students and early career researchers.

Only a reduced amount of talks should be given by senior researchers.

If possible, the invited talks could be given mainly by local experts that can attend with no expenses. Some senior researchers could propose themselves to attend the meeting and give a talk without being refunded.

peer-reviewed

YBNCT meetings should promote the quality of the talks ensuring that scientifically grounded results are presented, by abstract acceptance prior to the meeting or any other means to this aim, as usual. This will guarantee that all previous suggestions and considerations are not made at the expense of good science.
